

# HAVE YOU ENDED UP WITHOUT EMPLOYMENT, MEANS OF SUPPORT AND MONEY TO GET BACK HOME?

The Czech Republic is offering you a help to return to your country of origin in the form of participation in the **Project of voluntary returns!**

## What conditions do you have to meet to be able to participate in the project?

- You are a **legal alien**<sup>1</sup> living on the territory of the Czech Republic.
- You are not able to cover the cost of travel back home from your own resources.
- You have a **valid residence permit**<sup>2</sup>, or a **valid exit order** issued after the residence permit became invalid.
- **No deportation order was issued against you** (prohibited residence).

## What can you get?

- **Travel back to your country of origin**, including the ticket and pre-exit and transit assistance.
- **Allowance in the amount of €500 for an adult and €20** for a child under 15, which you will get at the airport.
- **Emergency accommodation** for the period from registration until exit from the Czech Republic, including basic food.
- **Participation in the project does not prevent you from coming back to the Czech Republic in the future.**

## How long is the offer valid?

- From **16th February 2009**.
- For the first **2000** applicants.
- Everybody can apply **just once**.

## Where can you apply for registration in the project? In what language?

- At all the relevant **Alien Police Inspectorates**.
- Detailed information will be provided in Czech language only.
- Make sure you accompanied by somebody speaking Czech for a phone or personal contact.
- **Your personal participation is always necessary!**
